

Code of Conduct for Parents and Guardians

As parents/guardians you are expected to:

- Positively reinforce your child and show an interest in their chosen activity at Camp or other Michaela Foundation activities/events.
- Do not place your child under pressure or push them into activities they do not want to do.
- Complete the relevant consent and registration forms, accurately and honestly.
- Deliver and collect your child punctually before and after Camp/Events.
- Ensure your child wears clothing appropriate to the weather conditions
- Ensure that proper sportswear and protective equipment (when necessary) are worn. Any child not in possession of the fundamental requirements will not be permitted to participate.
- Detail any relevant medical concerns or conditions pertaining to their child on the registration/consent form. Any changes in the state of the child's health should be reported to the Camp Coordinator/Event Coordinator/Michaela Foundation staff prior to the activity.
- Inform the Camp Coordinator or Michaela Foundation staff prior to the event/Camp starting if your child is to be collected early.
- Encourage your child to play by the rules, and teach them that they can only do their best.
- Ensure that your child understands their code of conduct.
- Behave responsibly when in attendance at Michaela Foundation events; do not embarrass your child.
- Show appreciation and support the leaders/instructors/Michaela Foundation staff.
- Ensure your child is punctual.
- Be realistic and supportive.
- Ensure your child has adequate food and drink.
- Promote your child's participation in activities for fun.

As a parents/guardians you have the right to:

- Be assured that your child is safeguarded during their participation in activities.
- Be informed of problems or concerns relating to your child.
- Be informed if your child is injured.
- Have your consent sought for issue such as trips or photography.
- Contribute to decisions within the club.
- Have any concerns about any aspect of your child's welfare listened to responded to.

Any breaches of this code of conduct will be dealt with immediately by a Michaela Foundation leader or staff member. Persistent concerns or breaches may result in you being asked not to attend Michaela



Foundation events/Camps if your attendance is considered detrimental to the welfare of young participants.

The ultimate action should a parent/guardian continue to breach the code of behaviour may be the Michaela Foundation regrettably asking your child to leave the session, event or Camp.
